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RELEASE OF SECURITY AGREEMENT

This Release Agreement dated as of October 30, 2003 ("Agreement") is made by Credit Suisse First Boston, as Collateral Agent ("Secured Party") in favor of Oil States International, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("U.S. Borrower").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Secured Party and U.S. Borrower have previously entered into a Security Agreement that was executed on February 14, 2001. Secured Party purportedly owns a security interest in U.S. Borrower's Intellectual Property, as described in the attached Exhibits A and B, which list the U.S. Patents and U.S. Trademark and Service Mark Registrations associated with this Agreement.



WHEREAS, the Parties now wish to terminate the Security Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein.
