**TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF SECURITY INTERESTS
IN CERTAIN PATENTS**

TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF SECURITY INTERESTS IN CERTAIN PATENTS ("Release"), dated as of November 12, 2003, by The CIT Group/Business Credit, Inc., a New York corporation ("CIT") and Fibermark, Inc., a Delaware corporation (the "Company").

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Fourth Amended and Restated Financing Agreement and Guaranty, dated as of January 31, 2003, between the Company and CIT ("Financing Agreement"), for the purpose of securing the obligations of the Company to CIT, the Company granted to CIT, for the benefit of the Lenders (as defined in the Financing Agreement), a security interest in and general lien on, all of its patents, patent registrations and associated goodwill, and all proceeds thereof, including, without limitation, the patents identified on Schedule A attached hereto (such patents referred to herein as the "Named Patents"); and

WHEREAS, CIT has agreed to terminate and release its security interest and all of its right, title and interest in each of the Named Patents as herein provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, CIT and the Company hereby agree as follows:

1. **Release and Assignment.** CIT hereby terminates and releases its security interest in and first priority lien on all of the Company's Named Patents, and CIT hereby assigns and transfers to the Company, without recourse, all of CIT's right, title and interest in and to each of the Named Patents and the related patent registrations and goodwill, effective as of the date set forth above.

2. **Acknowledgment and Acceptance.** The Company hereby acknowledges and accepts the foregoing release and assignment by CIT.

3. **Counterparts.** This Release may be executed in any number of counterparts which shall together constitute one and the same agreement.

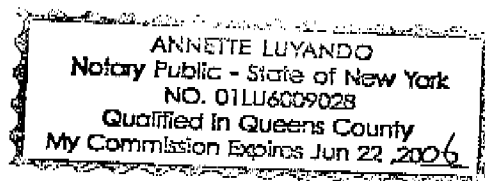
