I affirm that I have assigned all rights to the above-referenced invention in accordance with the Assignment executed by me (copy attached).

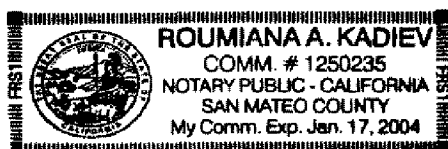
