**PATENT ASSIGNMENT FROM
ANTHONY J. O'LENICK, JR. TO LAMBENT TECHNOLOGIES CORP.**

This Assignment is made effective as of the 10th day of March, 2000 by and between Anthony J. O'Lenick, Jr. of 2170 Luke Edwards Road, Dacula, Georgia 30019 ("Assignor") and Lambent Technologies Corp., an Illinois corporation and a wholly owned subsidiary of Petroferm Inc. and having a place of business c/o Petroferm Inc., 2416 Lynndale Road, Fernandina Beach, Florida 32034 ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is identified as an inventor in each of the patents listed in attached Schedule A (hereafter "the Patents");

WHEREAS, Assignee is the successor of Lambent Technologies Inc. (hereafter "Lambent") as a result of the merger of Lambent into Assignee (Articles of Merger filed on June 30, 2000);

WHEREAS, prior to said merger, Lambent entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement (hereafter "the APA") on March 9, 2000 with The B. F. Goodrich Company, a New York corporation (hereafter "BFG") and, pursuant to the APA, was obligated to transfer interests in the Patents to BFG prior to the Closing Date of March 15, 2000 referred to in the APA (hereafter "the Closing Date");

WHEREAS, Assignor was employed by Lambent's predecessor in interest and by Lambent and, as a result of such employment, Assignor acknowledges that he was obliged to assign his interests in the inventions covered by the Patents and the Patents to Lambent prior to the Closing Date;

WHEREAS, Assignee, as the successor to Lambent, is subject to Lambent's obligations under the APA; and

WHEREAS, Assignee is desirous of acquiring Assignor's entire interests in the Patents, effective prior to the Closing Date, in order to satisfy, as Lambent's successor, its obligations under the APA;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing premises and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor by these presents does hereby sell, assign, transfer, and convey and does hereby confirm the sale, assignment, transfer and conveyance and does hereby quit claim to said Assignee, its successors and assigns, all of his right, title and interest in and to each of the patents listed in said Schedule A and in and to any reissue, reexamination, and extension thereof, and in and to the inventions described and claimed therein, throughout all countries of the world, whether previously assigned by him or not, the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee for its own use and for the use of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, to the end of the term or terms for which the patents are in effect as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this Assignment had not been made; and Assignor agrees further, at Assignee's expense and upon request of Assignee or Assignee's counsel, to execute such additional documents and to do all things as either may require to give full effect to and perfect the rights of the Assignee and its successors under this Assignment.
