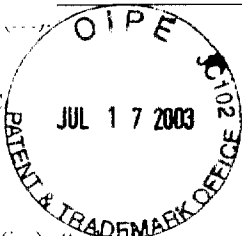

## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, XTERA COMMUNICATIONS, INC. (hereafter "Assignor"), a Delaware corporation, having an address of 500 West Bethany Drive, Allen, Texas 75013, is the owner of an interest in and to U.S. Patent Application No. 09/990,142 entitled "Broadband Amplifier and Communication System," filed November 20, 2001, and the inventions claimed therein (hereafter the "Patent Property"); and

WHEREAS, THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN (hereafter "Assignee"), having an address of Wolverine Tower, Room 2071, 3003 South State Street, Ann Arbor, Michigan 48109, desire to acquire Assignor's entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to Assignee, its right, title and interest in and to the Patent Property, as well as all divisions, continuations, re-issues, and re-examinations of said Patent Property, and all foreign counterparts of said Patent Property, said divisionals, and said continuations, subject, however, to Assignor retaining the rights in the Patent Property granted to Assignor in the License Agreement between Assignor and Assignee dated as of October 3, 2002 (the "License Agreement"), the rights assigned herein to be held and enjoyed by Assignee for its own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns, or legal representatives, to the end of the term or terms for which such Patent Property may be granted or reissued, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this assignment had not been made. Assignor's exclusive license rights in the Patent Property granted to Assignor in the License Agreement shall be unaffected by this Assignment.


Assignor further agrees to execute any and all powers of attorney, applications, assignments, declarations, affidavits, and any other papers in connection therewith necessary to perfect such right, title and interest in Assignee.

Assignor also assigns unto Assignee all claims for damages by reason of infringement prior to the assignment date of the Patent Property with the right to sue for and collect the same for its own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns and other legal representatives.

Assignor also will communicate to Assignee any facts known to it respecting any improvements; and, at the expense of Assignee, will testify in any legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers, execute all reissue and re-examination applications, make lawful oaths and declarations, and generally do everything possible to vest title in Assignee and to aid Assignee to obtain and enforce proper protection for said Patent Property.

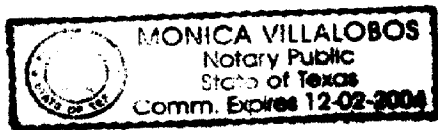
