PATENT ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, by a Patent Assignment dated September 30, 1997 Cybex International, Inc., a New York corporation ("Assignor"), transferred to Henley Healthcare, Inc. d/b/a Henley International, Inc., a Texas corporation ("Henley") its entire right, title and interest in and to U.S. Patent 4,725,056 and the patent disclosure and related application which issued as U.S. Patent 5,722,937, as more specifically identified below:

WHEREAS, Henley went bankrupt and defaulted on its debt to Comerica Bank - Texas, a Texas banking corporation ("Comerica"); and Comerica, as senior secured party, foreclosed on goods of Henley including the aforesaid patents; and

WHEREAS, after giving notice to the junior secured party, Comerica sold the aforesaid patents to Znetix Acquisition, L.P., a Texas limited partnership ("Znetix Acquisition"); and

WHEREAS, On March 30, 2001 Henley, via Comerica, assigned the aforesaid patents to Znetix Acquisition; and

WHEREAS, Znetix Acquisition became insolvent and Michael A. Grassmuck (the "Receiver") was appointed as receiver of the assets of Znetix Acquisition pursuant to an order issued by the United States District Court for the Western District of Washington at Seattle in an action entitled *Securities and Exchange Commission v. Health Maintenance Centers, Inc. et al.*, Case No. C02-0153P; and

WHEREAS, the Receiver, acting on behalf of Znetix Acquisition, sold the aforesaid patents to Computer Sports Medicine, Inc., a New Jersey corporation having a place of business at 57 Providence Highway, No. 5, Norwood, Massachusetts 02062 ("Assignee") as the highest bidder, after receiving competing bids; and

WHEREAS, Assignor executes and delivers this Patent Assignment in order to confirm title to the aforesaid patents in Assignee;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor, intending to be legally bound by these presents, for itself and its successors and assigns, does hereby assign to Assignee and its

successors and assigns the entire right, title and interest, if any, in and to the aforesaid patents, to the full end of the term of said patents and any and all continuations, reissues, extensions and renewals thereof, respectively, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had the foregoing Assignment dated September 30, 1997 not been made.
