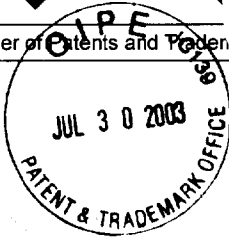


AND WHEREAS, the parties wish to execute a confirmatory assignment document for the purpose of recordal of the assignment at the various patent offices throughout the world.

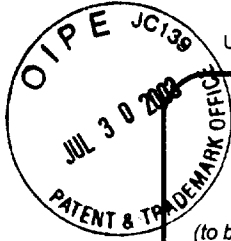

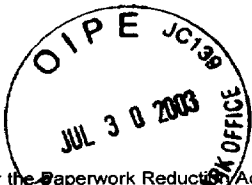
