ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION

WHEREAS, I, ELIZABETH A. GOLDBERG, residing at 901 General Wayne Drive, West Chester, PA 19382 is an employee of THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA, or was an employee of THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA at the time the invention was made, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and having an office and place of business at 34TH and Civic Center Boulevard, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19104; and

WHEREAS, I, ELIZABETH A. TO BE HELD AND ENJOYED by the said **THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA** and its legal representatives and assigns to the full ends of the terms for which said Letters Patent, or any of them, have granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me had no sale and assignment of said interest been made; and I do hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all Letters Patent which may be granted upon the said applications above referred to, or any of them, or upon said invention or any part thereof, or upon any improvements thereon which may be made, conceived or acquired

by me during the course of my association with the said company and for one year thereafter, to THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA aforesaid, and I hereby agree for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to execute without further consideration, any further legal documents and any further assignments and any releases, reissues, renewals or other applications for Letters Patent that may be deemed necessary by the Assignee herein named, fully to secure to the said Assignee its interest as aforesaid in and to said invention or any part thereof or any improvements thereon, and in and to said several Letters Patent, or any of them.

It is agreed that the undersigned shall be legally bound, upon request of THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA, to supply all information and evidence relating to the making and practice of said invention, to testify in any legal proceeding relating thereto, to execute all instruments proper to patent the invention throughout the world for the benefit of THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA, and to execute all instruments proper to carry out the intent of this instrument.

I do hereby covenant for myself and my legal representatives, and agree with THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA and its legal representatives, that I have granted no license to make or sell the said invention, that prior to the execution of this deed my right, title and interest in the said invention has not been encumbered, that I then had good right and title in and to the invention and that I have not executed and will not execute any instrument in conflict therewith.
