The Assignor and the Management Stockholders hereby appoint and constitute the Purchaser as the Assignor's and the Management Stockholders' attorney-in-fact to act for the Assignor and the Management Stockholders and in their respective names, place, and stead, but for the Purchaser's own benefit, to: (i) assert or enforce any of the Assignor's and the Management Stockholders' rights, title or interest in the Patents, (ii) sign the Assignor's and the Management Stockholders' name and take any action necessary to transfer all rights in the Patents to the Purchaser.




