ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS AGREEMENT**

This Nunc Pro Tunc Assignment of Security Interests and Assignment of Patents Agreement is made and entered as of the 24th day of January, 2003, by and among U.S. Bank of Washington National Association, a national banking association having a place of business at 1420 Fifth Avenue, 10th Floor, Seattle, Washington 98101 ("Assignor"), CODA-Gargoyles LLC, a Delaware limited liability company having a place of business at 25 ½ East 61st Street, New York, New York 10021 ("Assignee"), Gargoyles, Inc., a Washington corporation having a place of business at 521 8th Street, S.W., Suite D, Auburn, Washington 98001 ("Gargoyles"), and Sungold Eyewear, Inc. a Washington corporation having a place of business at 521 8th Street, S.W., Suite D, Auburn, Washington 98001 ("Sungold," and collectively with Gargoyles, the "Borrowers").

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee entered into that certain Securities Purchase Agreement by and among Gargoyles, Inc., U.S. Bank National Association and Coda-Gargoyles, LLC, dated January 24, 2003 (the "Securities Purchase Agreement") pursuant to which Assignee obtained certain rights and security interests to the intellectual property assets of the Borrowers held as collateral by Assignor to secure indebtedness of the Borrowers (the "Collateral"); and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto now desire to reflect the transfer of any security interests in the Collateral now held by Assignor and assignment of the intellectual property assets, including but not limited to the patents identified on Schedule A hereto (the "Patents") to Assignee by virtue of the Securities Purchase Agreement in a form suitable for recording with the United States Patent and Trademark Office;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree to the following:

1. Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee any and all security interests, liens, rights claims or demands, of any kind whatsoever, which Assignor now has or might have in or to the Patents shown on Schedule A attached hereto, and incorporated herein by reference, by virtue of certain documents and agreements entered into dated April 7, 1997 and January 15, 1998, granting security interests in favor of Assignor by the Borrowers, or by virtue of any other security interest granted in favor of Assignor by the Borrowers on or after April 7, 1997 (collectively, the "Security Agreements & Interests").

2. Assignor hereby sells, assigns and transfers to Assignee any right, title, and interest in, to and under the Patents now held by Assignor and in all divisions, reissues, continuations, and extensions thereof (the "Patents"), and all rights and causes of action to recover past, present or future damages, royalties, fees, profits or other relief, including equitable and injunctive relief ensuing from infringement of the Patents. Assignor and Borrowers further represent and warrant that they have not transferred, assigned, hypothecated, or granted a security interest in the Patents to any third party other than any assignments previously made to Assignee under the Securities Purchase Agreement.
