

WHEREAS, EVENTION, L.L.C., an Arkansas limited liability company, having a principal place of business at 1100 Skyline, North Little Rock, Arkansas 72116 (hereinafter referred to as "**Assignor**"), is the exclusive owner of the new and novel device set forth in United States Letters Patent number 6,041,722, entitled EVENT TABLES, issued on March 28, 2000; is the exclusive owner of the new and novel device set forth in United States Letters Patent number 6,324,997, entitled CONNECTABLE EVENT TABLES, issued December 4, 2001; and is the exclusive owner of the new and novel device set forth in United States Letters Patent number D455,305, entitled TABLE TOP WITH INTERCHANGEABLE LEAVES, issued April 9, 2002; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Promissory Note between Assignor and **Ed Weber**, an individual and citizen of the United States (hereinafter referred to as "**Assignee**"), dated October 31, 2002, Assignor purchased Assignee's membership interest in and to Assignor; and

WHEREAS, to secure payment of that Promissory Note and pursuant to a Pledge and Security Agreement between Assignor and Assignee, dated October 31, 2002, Assignor collaterally assigned, transferred and pledged to Assignee and granted to Assignee a first and prior security interest in, all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to those said United States Letters Patent, along with all proceeds associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, Assignor has determined that payment due under said Promissory Note will not be possible and wishes to accelerate transfer to the Assignee of the United States Letters Patent pledged as security thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, TO ALL WHICH IT MAY CONCERN: Be it known that for good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the parties hereto, Assignor hereby sells, assigns and transfers to Assignee the full and exclusive right, title and interest, national and international, to all the above United States Letters Patent.

Assignor hereby covenants that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been, or will be, made or entered into which would conflict with this Assignment and sale.

Assignor further covenants that Assignee will, upon its request, be provided promptly with all pertinent facts and documents relating to said Letters Patent as may be known and accessible to Assignor and will testify to the same in any interference or litigation related thereto and will promptly execute and deliver to Assignee, or his legal representative, any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain and enforce said Letters Patent which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes hereof.
