ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, **Ping Wang** (hereinafter "the Assignor"), a citizen of the United States of America, and residing at 3 Ridge Drive East, Roslyn, New York 11576, has invented certain new and useful improvements in **TREATMENT OF SHOCK USING ADRENOMEDULLIN AND ADRENOMEDULLIN BINDING PROTEIN-1**, for which a utility patent application for United States Letters Patent having Serial No. 10/439,762 was filed on May 16, 2003; and

Assignor hereby authorizes the Assignee and its successors to apply for a patent or patents directly in its own name, upon the aforesaid invention, wherever the same is permitted by law, and also assigns, sells, transfers, and sets over unto the Assignee and its successors all priority rights under the aforesaid application.

Assignor further covenants to execute all additional instruments, and to do all things necessary to carry out the purpose of this instrument, at the expense of the Assignee and its successors.
