WHEREAS we, Eugene A. Woltering, a citizen of the United States, having a mailing address at 30 Chateau Pontet Canet, Kenner, LA 70065; Conrad A. Each of us further agrees for himself or herself and for his or her heirs, executors, and administrators, to execute and deliver without further consideration any further applications, oaths, declarations, assignments, and other documents, and to perform such acts as we lawfully may, that may be deemed necessary by the said Board of Supervisors




