ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION

WHEREAS, I, JEREMY MARK COHEN, residing at 1226 Fairacres Road, Jenkintown, PA 19046, **LUIS OTOYA**, residing at 4650 North Washington Boulevard, Apartment 1025, Arlington, VA 22201, **KRISTY BITTENBENDER ARBOGAST**, residing at 160 Fox Road, Media, PA 19063 and **FLAURA KOPLIN WINSTON**, residing at 317 Merion Avenue, Narberth, PA 19072, are employees of THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA, or were employees of THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA at the time the invention was made, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and having an office and place of business at 34TH and Civic Center Boulevard, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania 19104; and

WHEREAS, I, JEREMY MARK COHEN, LUIS OTOYA, KRISTY BITTENBENDER ARBOGAST, and FLAURA KOPLIN WINSTON, have made a certain new and useful invention in **RETROFIT SAFETY HANDLEBAR**, and have filed an application for Letters Patent of the United States Patent and Trademark Office on May 29, 2002, and assigned Application Serial No. 10/157,401, continuation in part of U.S. Serial No. 09/675,743 filed on September 29, 2000; and



It is agreed that the undersigned shall be legally bound, upon request of THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA, to supply all information and evidence relating to the making and practice of said invention, to testify in any legal proceeding relating thereto, to execute all instruments proper to patent the invention throughout the world for the benefit of THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA, and to execute all instruments proper to carry out the intent of this instrument.

We do hereby covenant for ourselves and our legal representatives, and agree with THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF PHILADELPHIA and its legal representatives, that we have granted no license to make or sell the said invention, that prior to the execution of this deed our right, title and interest in the said invention has not been encumbered, that we then had good right and title in and to the invention and that we have not executed and will not execute any instrument in conflict therewith.
