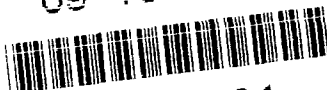

WHEREAS, we, Martin C. BARUCH, David W. GERDT, and Charles ADKINS, citizens of the United States, residing at Charlottesville, Charlottesville, and Earlysville, Virginia, respectively, have invented certain novel and useful improvements in
