instrument or assignment in conflict herewith;

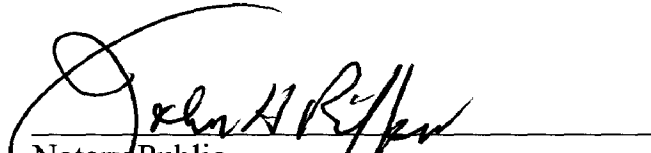

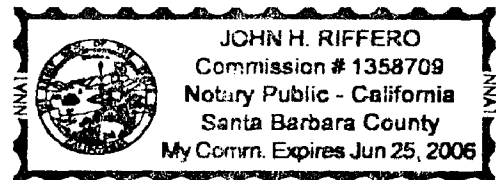
