invented by Peter Dorney and the application for United States patent therefor filed 06/28/1999, Serial Number 09/342,402, issued as United States Patent Number 6,062,380 issued May 16, 2000, and all reissued patents granted therefor, and all divisions and continuations thereof, including the subject matter of any and all claims which may be obtained in every such patent, and the right to apply for and obtain patents in countries foreign to the United States, and in and to any Letters Patent which may be granted thereon in such foreign countries, and authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to successors, assigns, nominees or other legal representatives, as assignee and owner of the said entire interest and covenant, that it assigned and that it has not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict herewith, and agree that it will communicate to said assignee, its successors, assigns, nominees or other legal representatives, all facts known to it respecting said invention whenever requested, and testify in any legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers, execute and deliver all divisional, continuing or reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and do all lawful acts requisite for the application for such divisional, continuing or reissue application, or the procuring thereof, and that if and when said assignee, its successors, assigns, nominees or other legal representatives desire to file a disclaimer relating thereto, it will, upon request, sign and deliver all
