ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment Agreement is entered into this 18th day of August 2003 between: **CASE HARVESTING SYSTEMS, GmbH**, of Berghausstraße 1, D-01844 Neustadt, Germany; **Ingo MENDE** of Lauensteiner Straße 9b, D-01277 Dresden, Germany and **Henri SCHOLTKE** of Hauptstraße 8, D-02692 Obergurig, Germany [hereinafter referred to as the Assignors] of the first Part and **NEW HOLLAND NORTH AMERICA, INC.**, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, having a place of business at New Holland, Pennsylvania, United States of America [hereinafter referred to as the Assignee], its successors, and assigns, of the second Part.

WHEREAS, the said **Ingo MENDE** and **Henri SCHOLTKE** [hereinafter referred to as the Inventors] are/have been in the employ of the said Case Harvesting Systems GmbH within the jurisdiction of the Laws of Germany, and are the true and first and joint Inventors of an invention [hereinafter referred to as the Invention] entitled "**A travelling gear for agricultural working machine**", the specification of which was filed on April 2, 2003 as U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 10/405,428;

WHEREAS, the Assignee is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to the Invention in the country of the United States of America;



AND WHEREAS, the said **CASE HARVESTING SYSTEMS, GmbH** is joining in the execution of this Assignment Agreement to convey said right, title and interest as described below and vested therein by virtue of the contract of employment with the Inventor and by virtue of any other agreements or rights of law or equity;


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of one dollar and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Assignors hereby sell, assign, and transfer to the Assignee the entire right, title and interest in the country of the United States of America in and to the Invention and in and to any patent application and patent granted thereon filed in said country, and including all divisions, reissues, continuations, and extensions of any such patent application and of all corresponding right of priority resulting from the filing thereof, and authorize and request that any and all said patents be issued to said Assignee, or its successors and assigns. The Assignors covenant that they have full rights and power to enter into this Assignment Agreement and agree that they will communicate to the Assignee or its representative, all facts known to them respecting the Invention, whenever requested, and that they will testify or provide access to personnel to testify in any legal proceeding, and that they will sign all lawful papers, execute all division, continuation and reissue applications, and make all rightful oaths, and generally do everything possible to aid the Assignee, its successors, assigns, and nominees, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for the Invention in said country.



