WHEREAS, Richard R. Schrock, Amir H. Hoveyda, MIT, and BOSTON COLLEGE agree that all right, title and interest in and to said U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/114,692 (U.S. Patent No. 6,346,652) and 09/743,859 would properly both have been transferred to MIT and BOSTON COLLEGE jointly;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We the undersigned hereby

Sell, assign and transfer, or assent to the sale, assignment and transfer, to MIT and BOSTON COLLEGE, as joint owners each having a 50%, undivided interest, their successors, assigns and legal representatives, all hereinafter referred to as the Assignee, *nunc pro tunc* July 13, 1998, the entire right, title and interest for the United States and all foreign countries, in and to any and all inventions which are disclosed in the following patents and patent applications:
