ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Nobuaki Hanaoka, Yasunori Maekawa, Yasumasa Akai and Satoshi Nakayama, hereinafter called the "Assignors", have made the invention described in the United States patent application entitled, METHODS FOR DETECTING MALARIA PARASITES AND REAGENT KITS THEREFOR, executed by Assignors on the same date as this Assignment;

patents; and in the prosecution of any interference which may arise involving said invention, or any such patent application or patent; and that the Assignors will execute and deliver to the Assignee any and all additional papers which may be requested by the Assignee to carry out the terms of this Assignment.

The Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks is hereby authorized and requested to issue patents to the Assignee in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.


