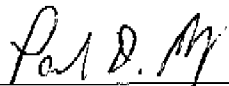

Convention.

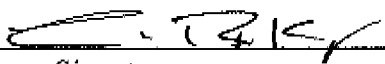
The Assignors further agree, for themselves and their legal representatives, they will assist
