## **ASSIGNMENT**

ASSIGNORS HEREBY warrant and covenant that they have full right to convey the entire right, title and interest herein assigned free and clear of all licenses, encumbrances and liens whatsoever, and that they have not executed and will not execute any instrument or assignment in conflict with this Assignment.

ASSIGNORS HEREBY agree to communicate to Aerial Machine & Tool Corporation or its representatives any facts known to them respecting the Invention, to execute all patent applications (including but not limited to all divisional, continuation, reissue, and foreign patent applications) and applications for legal equivalent of patent, sign all lawful documents and make all rightful oaths and declarations relating to the Invention, and to testify in any judicial or administrative proceeding, and generally do everything reasonable to aid Aerial Machine & Tool Corporation to obtain and enforce any and all patents and legal equivalents in the United States or any foreign country when requested so to do by Aerial Machine & Tool Corporation.


