## **PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT**

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into as of this 14th day of May, 2004 ("Effective Date"), by and between DR. This represents Assignor's entire interest in the Assigned Patents, and the Assigned Patents will be held and enjoyed by Assignee, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, to the full end of the term for which the Assigned Patents, and any and all patent applications or patents issued therefrom, are granted.

2. Assignor will sign all papers and drawings, including assignment documents in the Patent Office, make all rightful oaths, affidavits and declarations, and do all acts necessary or required to be done for the procurement and maintenance of valid patents for the Assigned Patents, or for all continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, extensions, reexaminations, reissues, and substitutes thereof, and to all counterparts in all countries throughout the world, and all rights of priority therein under international agreements, treaties and conventions in every participating country. Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the United States Patent Office and other foreign offices whose duty it is to issue patents to issue letters patent in respect to any patent applications listed in Schedule A to the Assignee, for the full term for which such letters patent may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by the Assignor had this Assignment not been made.
