On the date shown below, and for good and valuable consideration the receipt of which is acknowledged, Vernay Laboratories, Inc., an Ohio corporation having offices at 120 East South College Street, Yellow Springs, Ohio 45387 ("Vernay") made the following assignments and promises to Medical Ventures, L.L.C., a Kansas limited liability company ("Medical Ventures") having offices at 12619 Pawnee Lane, Leawood, Kansas 66209 (Medical Ventures), in connection with Vernay's ownership of the following inventions, patents and patent applications ("Patents"):

1. Vernay hereby assigns, transfers, and conveys to Medical Ventures the entire right, title and interest in and to

- (a) the aforementioned inventions;
- (b) the aforementioned applications for United States and foreign Letters Patent;
- (c) any Letters Patent issued pursuant to, or as a result of, the applications referenced above;
- (d) all applications for Letters Patent, or similar legal protection, which may be filed in any country or countries foreign to the United States with respect to the Inventions;
- (e) all Letters Patent which may be granted for the Inventions in any country or countries foreign to the United States; and

- (f) all extensions, renewals, reissues, divisions, and continuations (or their legal equivalents) of any applications or Letters Patent referred to above.

2. Vernay authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States whose duty it is to issue patents or similar legal protection on applications, to issue to Medical Ventures all Letters Patent or similar legal protection for the Invention.

3. Vernay agrees that, upon the request of Medical Ventures, It will

- (a) execute any and all divisional and renewal applications arising out of the applications and patents referred to above for the Inventions;
- (b) execute any supplemental oaths relating to the Inventions;
- (c) execute any applications for reissue or extension of any Letters Patent that may be granted upon the applications referred to above;
- (d) cooperate to the best of its ability in connection with any Interference proceeding, including but not limited to, cooperation in connection with preparing the preliminary statement and giving and producing evidence in support of such preliminary statement;
- (e) perform any and all affirmative acts to obtain Letters Patent and vest all right in such Letters Patent in Medical Ventures; and
- (f) perform such additional acts as Medical Ventures may deem necessary or expedient in connection with any of the matters stated above.

4. Vernay covenants and warrants that as of January 19, 2001, the date of the Purchase Agreement between the parties, it was the true and lawful owner of the entire right, title, and interest in the Inventions, applications for Letters Patent, any Letters Patent which may issue under said applications as well as all issued Letters Patent, and had the full right and power to convey the same; that the same were as of that date free and clear of all liens, charges and encumbrances whatsoever; and that it has not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict with this Assignment Agreement.

5. This Assignment Agreement is binding upon, shall inure to the benefit of, and shall be performed by the parties named, their heirs, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns.
