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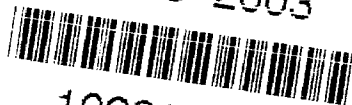

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office to issue any and all United States Letters Patents to be obtained for said invention to Assignee as assignee of the rights and interest herein assigned, for Assignee's sole use and behoof and for the use and behoof of Assignee's legal representatives, to the full end of the terms for which Letters Patents may be granted, as fully and entirely as said Letters Patents would have been held by Assignor had this assignment and sale not been made.

Assignor further covenants and agrees that Assignee will, at any time, upon Assignee's request, be provided with all pertinent facts and documents relating to said application, said invention and any said Letters Patents as may be known and accessible to Assignor and will testify as to the same in any interference or other litigation relating thereto, and will promptly execute and deliver to Assignee or its legal representatives any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain, issue and enforce said application, said invention and any said

Letters Patents and equivalents thereof which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes thereof.
