

APPOINTMENT OF INVESTIGATOR AS AGENT

Appointment by the Howard Hughes Medical Institute (the "Institute") of Stephen T. Warren, PhD, an investigator employed by the Institute, as its agent for the purpose of assigning certain rights to Emory University (the "University").

WHEREAS, the Institute and the University collaborate in the active conduct of medical research pursuant to an Agreement between them dated as of August 15, 1991 (the "Agreement");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the Institute has agreed to assign to the University the Institute's rights with respect to inventions, discoveries, improvements, and other intellectual property, whether patentable or copyrightable (each a "Subject Property"), conceived or reduced to practice in the course of the research program conducted under the Agreement by employees of the Institute;


WHEREAS, research conducted pursuant to the Agreement by Stephen T. Warren, PhD while employed by the Institute at the University has resulted in the invention of a certain Subject Property entitled "Method for the Treatment of Mental Retardation," which is the subject of a provisional patent application entitled "Method For the Treatment of Mental Retardation" filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on April 2, 2001 with Serial Number 60/280,915, and the Invention is a Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, the Institute wishes Stephen T. Warren, PhD to act as its agent for the purpose of assigning to the University the rights the Institute has in the Invention by reason of the research program conducted at the University,


