

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## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, VLADIMIR DRAGANOV, a citizen of Canada residing at #73-1140 Falcon Drive, Coquitlam, British Columbia, Canada V3E 2K1, ROBERT T. CARLSON, a citizen of the United States residing at #14343 – 32B Avenue, Surrey, British Columbia, Canada V4P 2K6, ROBERT L. KEHR, a citizen of the United States residing at 5229 Horned Owl Way, Parker, Colorado 80134, DEREK G. MONTGOMERY, a citizen of Canada residing at 1702-320 Royal Avenue, New Westminster, British Columbia, Canada V3L 5C6, PABLO BANDERA, a citizen of the United States residing at 701-1099 Marinaside Crescent, Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada V6Z 2Z3, and DARYL G. 
