Joint Inventorship

WHEREAS, Jürgen Spä h and Benno Petersen, all citizens of the Federal Republic of Germany and respectively residing at Hildegardring 8, 88662 Überlingen, Germany, and at Reichenauer Weg 6, 88690 Uhldingen, Germany, and hereinafter called the "Assignors", have invented a new and useful METHOD AND DEVICE FOR READING PROGRAMS INTO A DEVICE CONTROLLED BY A PROCESSOR, for a full description of which reference is here made to an application for Letters Patent of the United States executed on even date herewith; and *Serial No. 09/623,656, filed 11/27/2000.*




And the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks is hereby authorized and requested to issue Letters Patent to the said Assignee in accordance with the terms of this assignment.
