

RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

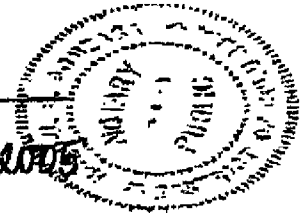
