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## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Carlisle (NMI) Thweatt, Jr. residing at 556 North Shore Drive, South Haven, Michigan 49090 respectively (hereinafter referred to as Assignor), has invented certain new and useful improvements in HEATER HAVING OVER TEMPERATURE SHUT OFF CONTROL for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on even date herewith.


