ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, JAN S. IWANCZYK AND BRADLEY E. PATT, residing at 3066 Corda Drive, Los Angeles, California 90049 and 5416 Katherine Avenue, Sherman Oaks, California 91401, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements disclosed in an application for United States Letters Patent entitled **METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR FABRICATING MERCURIC IODIDE POLYCRYSTALLINE FILMS FOR DIGITAL RADIOGRAPHY**, filed May 30, 2002, Application No. 10/158,494, now published as U.S. Publication No. US 2003/0021382 A1 ("the published patent application") on January 30, 2003, together with claim to the priority of United States Provisional Application No. 60/308,967, filed July 30, 2001.

AND WHEREAS PHOTON IMAGING, INC., a California corporation, having a place of business at 19355 Business Center Drive, Suite 8, Northridge, California 91324 (hereafter, together with any successors, legal representatives or assigns thereof, called "ASSIGNEE") wants to acquire the entire right, title and interest in and to said improvements and application.

(ii) any and all claims and demands that we may have against any firm, person or corporation relating to said application including, but not limited to, any claim of infringement or claim of provisional rights, together with the right to retain for ASSIGNEE any and all sums that ASSIGNEE may obtain or recover as a result of the assertion or enforcement of any such claim or demand; and

we hereby authorize and request the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and any officials of foreign countries whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all patents for said improvements to ASSIGNEE in accordance with the terms of this Assignment;

AND WE HEREBY covenant that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith;

AND WE HEREBY further covenant and agree that we will communicate to ASSIGNEE any facts known to us respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, substitute and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid ASSIGNEE to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in all countries.



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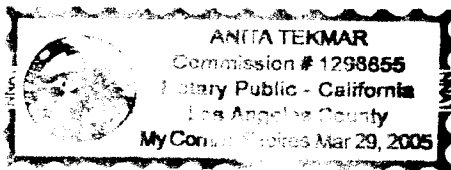

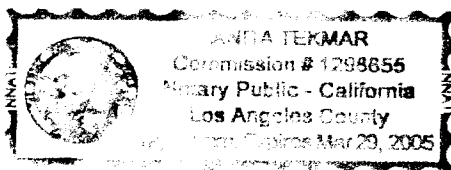
