ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Thomas H. Lynch, residing at 21208 Nashville, Chatsworth, California 91311; Erich H. Soendker, residing at 17226 Ludlow Street, Granada Hills, California 91304; and Thomas A. Hertel, residing at 28214 Ridge View Drive, Santa Clarita, California 91387(hereinafter "Assignor") have invented certain new and useful improvements in HIGH TEMPERATURE POWER SUPPLY (hereinafter "invention") for which Assignor is making or has made application for LETTERS PATENT OF THE UNITED STATES, which application has been duly executed by Assignor on date(s) listed below.

Assignee will hold all rights for its own use and benefit and for the use and benefit of its successors or assigns to the full end of the term for which the LETTERS PATENT may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignors if this assignment and sale had not been made. Assignors request and authorizes the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, U.S. and its foreign counterparts, to issue the LETTERS PATENT when granted, in accordance with this assignment.

Assignors further covenant and agree with the Assignee that Assignors have a full and unencumbered title to the invention, which title Assignors warrant to the Assignee. Assignors further agree that Assignors will, without demanding any further consideration therefor, at the request and expense of the Assignee, do all lawful and just acts, including the execution and acknowledgement of instruments, that may be or become necessary for

obtaining, sustaining, extending, reissuing or reexamining United States and foreign LETTERS PATENT or the like for the invention, and for maintaining and perfecting the Assignee's right to the invention and LETTERS PATENT, particularly in cases of interference conflict, opposition and litigation.
