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ASSIGNMENT OF THE INVENTION

WHEREAS, we, JOHN H. BREKKE, GINO BRADICA and SCOTT M. GOLDMAN, residing in the city of Duluth, County of St. Louis, and city of Claremont, County of Sullivan, and city of Paoli, County of Chester, respectively; of the State of Minnesota, and the State of New Hampshire, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, respectively, have made a certain new and useful invention in a DEVICE FOR REGENERATION OF ARTICULAR CARTILAGE AND OTHER TISSUE, and having applied for Letters Patent of the United States based thereon, the application which may be identified in the United States Patent and Trademark Office by serial no. 10/199,961 filed 07/19/2002;



We do hereby covenant for ourselves and our legal representatives, and agree with KENSEY NASH CORPORATION, and its legal representatives, that we have granted no license to make or sell the said invention, that prior to the execution of this deed our right, title and interest in the said invention has not been encumbered, that we then had good right and title in and to the invention and that we have not executed and will not execute any instrument in conflict therewith.
