ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Jean-Michel Paul, residing at 30 rue de Queuleu, 57070 Metz, France and Bernard Dupont, residing at 40 rue de la Mine, 57150 Creutzwald, France, both citizens of France, hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNORS, have invented and own a certain invention entitled:
