PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This Patent Assignment ("Assignment") is effective as of the date set forth below, by and between Annie Y. Sweeney, as Personal Representative of the Estate of Gerald T. Sweeney ("**Assignor**"), and Annie Y. Sweeney, an individual and a resident of the state of Washington ("**Assignee**").

WHEREAS, Assignor desires to assign all of the right, title and interest in and to the Patent, and Assignee desires to acquire the entire right, title and interest in and to the Patent.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, and in distribution of the assets of the above-described estate, Assignor hereby acknowledges and agrees to the following:

Assignor does hereby acknowledge that Assignor has irrevocably assigned, granted, and conveyed, and does hereby irrevocably assign, grant, and convey, and agree to assign, grant, and convey, unto Assignee and, in the event Assignee so designates, her designated successors, legal representatives and assigns (such successors, legal representatives and assigns referred to collectively with Assignee as the "**Recipients**"), the Assignor's entire right, title and interest in, to and under:

(i) the Patent;

(ii) all substitutions, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, re-examinations, and extensions of the Patent (the "**United States Patents**");

(iii) all patents, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, re-examinations, and extensions claiming subject matter related to or deriving from the subject matter disclosed in the Patent and/or United States Patents (the "**Improvement Patents**");

(iv) all patents, petty patents, utility models, certificates of invention or other indicia of invention ownership, including any renewals thereof, which have been or may hereafter be granted by any entity authorized to grant such indicia of inventions ownership in any jurisdiction(s) foreign to the United States for any of the subject matter disclosed in the Patent, United States Patents, and/or Improvement Patents (the "**Worldwide Patents**");

(v) with respect to the Patent, United States Patents, Improvement Patents, and Worldwide Patents, all priority or other rights granted by or provided for in the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it, and any other convention providing for the protection of inventions;

(vi) with respect to the Patent, United States Patents, Improvement Patents, and Worldwide Patents, all priority or other rights granted by or provided for in any patent cooperation and/or registration treaty;

(vii) all applications for any of the foregoing items (i) through (vi) (items (i) through (vi) are collectively referred to as the "**Assigned Patents**"); and

(viii) the right, if any, to sue or bring any claim or action for past, present and future infringement of the Assigned Patents.

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents of the United States, and any official of any jurisdiction foreign to the United States whose right it is to issue indicia of invention ownership, to issue all patents or such indicia for the applicable Assigned Patents to the Recipients.

Assignor hereby covenants and agrees that Assignor will: (i) cooperate with the Recipients in the prosecution of U.S. patent applications and foreign counterparts on the inventions described in the Assigned Patents; (ii) communicate to the Recipients any facts known to Assignor respecting the Assigned Patents, and testify in any legal proceedings, sign all required papers, execute all applications, execute and participate in all requests for re-examination, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid the Recipients to obtain, maintain and enforce proper patent protection for the Assigned Patents in all jurisdictions; (iii) execute, acknowledge and deliver to the Recipients any and all further instruments and assurances necessary or expedient in order to vest rights assigned hereunder more effectively in the Recipients; and (iv) execute, acknowledge and deliver to the Recipients any and all further instruments and assurances necessary or expedient in order to confirm and/or record the rights assigned hereunder to the Recipients. This Patent Assignment states the entire and only agreement of the parties relating to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior representations, agreements, understandings, course of dealings and negotiations regarding the same.
