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RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS

THIS RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS (this "Release") is made as of August 10, 2004 ("Effective Date") by and between NATIONAL SEATING COMPANY, a Delaware corporation, with its principal office at 200 National Drive, Vonore, Tennessee 37885 ("Grantor"), and BANK OF AMERICA, N.A., a National Association, with its principal office at 231 S. LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois 60697, as Collateral Agent ("Collateral Agent")

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms and conditions of that certain Patent Security Agreement by and between Grantor and Collateral Agent dated October 5, 2000 (the "Patent Security Agreement"), Grantor granted to Collateral Agent a continuing security interest in and to all of Grantor's right, title and interest in and to the Collateral (as defined in the Patent Security Agreement), including, without limitation, the United States patents set forth on Schedule A attached hereto, the United States patent applications set forth on Schedule B attached hereto, and the patent license agreements set forth on Schedule C attached hereto (collectively, the "Patents");

WHEREAS, Grantor and Collateral Agent entered into the Patent Security Agreement pursuant to the terms and conditions of that certain Credit Agreement by and between Grantor, CVS Holdings, Inc. and Collateral Agent dated October 5, 2000 (the "Credit Agreement");

WHEREAS, the Patent Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("PTO") on October 27, 2000 at Reel 011213, Frame 0599;

WHEREAS, Grantor has paid all of its outstanding indebtedness to Collateral Agent; and

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent wishes to: (i) terminate the Patent Security Agreement and the Credit Agreement; (ii) terminate, cancel and release any and all security interests it has against the Patents; (iii) restore all right, title and interest in and to the Patents to Grantor; and (iv) dissolve any and all liens and encumbrances with respect to the Patents.


NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Collateral Agent does hereby release its security interest in the Patents, including those set forth on Schedules A, B and C attached hereto, and discharges, quit claims and relinquishes unto Grantor (in each case without recourse and without any representation or warranty) any and all right, title and interest it has in and the security interest granted to Collateral Agent in the Patents, including those listed in the aforementioned schedules.

Collateral Agent shall take all further actions, and provide to Grantor, Grantor's successors, assigns or other legal representatives, all such cooperation and assistance (including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of any and all documents or other instruments), reasonably requested by Grantor to more fully and effectively effectuate the purposes of this Release.
