ASSIGNMENT OF UNITED STATES PATENT

WHEREAS, Jobin Yvon Inc., a Delaware corporation, having an address at 3880 Park Avenue, Edison, New Jersey 08820 ("Assignor"), is the owner of the United States patent set forth on the annexed Schedule and related inventions thereof (the "Letters Patent");

WHEREAS, Metuchen Scientific, Inc., a Delaware corporation, having an address at 203 Norcross Avenue, Metuchen, New Jersey 08840 ("Assignee"), desires to acquire the entire undivided right, title and interest in and to the Letters Patent;
