PATENT ASSIGNMENT

THIS PATENT ASSIGNMENT (the "Assignment") is made as of the date of execution, provided below (the "Execution Date"), and is effective as of November 1, 1994 (the "Effective Date"), from Curtis E. Lynch and Nicholas J. Lichter (the "Assignors") to Jupiter Transportation Company (the "Assignee").

RECITALS

A. Assignors are inventors relating to certain patents entitled "Apparatus for the Transportation of Trucks": United States Patent No. 5,772,677 issued March 3, 1998 and United States Patent No. 6,120,051 issued September 19, 2000 (the "Patents").

B. Assignors desire to execute this Assignment to confirm assignment of all of their rights, title, and interest in and to the Patents to Jupiter Transportation Company and to ATC Leasing Company, a successor and assignee of Jupiter Transportation Company, which occurred before November 4, 1994.

C. Subsequent to the Effective Date of this Assignment, on November 4, 1994, the Patents, by application serial no. 08/291,767, were assigned from Jupiter Transportation Company, n/k/a Active Acquisition Corp., to Jupiter Corp. Transportation System, as evidenced by the recording with the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Reel/Frame 7521/0997.

D. Subsequent to the Effective Date of this Assignment, on November 4, 1994, the Patents were assigned from Jupiter Corp. Transportation System to ATC Leasing Company, as evidenced by the recording with the United States Patent and Trademark Office at Reel/Frame 7521/0982.

Assignors hereby assign and transfer to Assignee, its successors and assigns any and all claims or causes of action for infringement of the Patents that may have accrued, together with the right to bring suit for and/or initiate any proceeding to collect any and all damages arising from said claims or causes of action.
