#### RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Lender does hereby release its security interest in the Patents, including those set forth on Schedule A attached hereto, and discharges, quit claims and relinquishes unto Assignor (in each case without recourse and without any representation or warranty) any and all right, title and interest it has in and the security interest granted to Lender in the Patents, including those listed in the aforementioned schedules.
