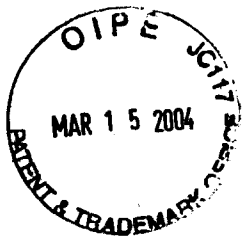

ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION AND OF LETTERS PATENT

Whereas, we, Walton Sumner, II of 7 Old Westbury Lane, Webster Groves, Missouri 63119; Jim Zhong Xu of 4877 Keats Grove Lane, Lexington, Kentucky 40513; Guy H. Roussel of 611 Elsmere Park, Lexington, Kentucky 40508; and Michael D. 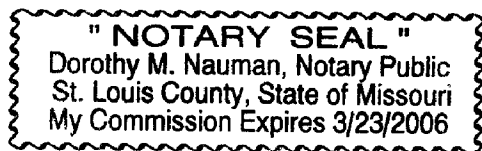
