



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
It is submitted that the error in the recordation form cover sheet of 23 January 2002 is apparent when the cover sheet is compared to the 19 June 2000 assignment as recorded. Specifically, lines 4 and 5 of page 1 of the assignment of 19 June 2000 identify the assignor as Datastrip Products Inc., a corporation then having a principal place of business at 1 Research Drive, Shelton, CT 06484. The recordation form cover sheet, however, erroneously identified the conveying party as Stephen M. Hunt, who, as is apparent from page 3 of the assignment, was the CEO of the corporate assignor Datastrip Products Inc. and who executed the assignment on 19 June 2000 on behalf of the assignor Datastrip Products Inc.

Under 37 CFR 3.34(a) and (b), an error in a recordation form cover sheet will be corrected if: (a)(1) "[t]he error is apparent when the cover sheet is compared to the recorded document to which it pertains," (a)(2) "[a] corrected cover sheet is filed for recordation," and (b) [t]he corrected cover sheet [is] accompanied by the originally recorded document ... and by the recording fee as set forth in § 3.41." It is submitted that the specified conditions of 37 CFR 3.34 are fully satisfied in connection with the present request and that therefore the recordation form cover sheet for the 19 June 2000 assignment and the records of the Patent and Trademark Office pertaining to the assignment should be updated to identify the correct assignor, Datastrip Products Inc. Such action is earnestly solicited.
