## **ASSIGNMENT**



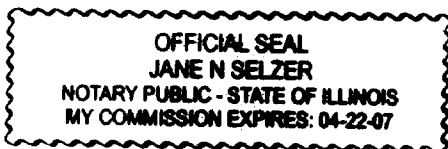

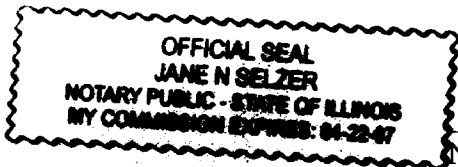
