3 We, John E. McDowell, Clark E. Hinds and John L. Fleskes hereby authorize  
4 and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all said  
5 Letters Patent to the said Cetacea Sound, Inc. (Assignee), as the assignee of the  
6 entire right, title, and interest in and to the same, for its sole use and behoof; and for  
7 the use and behoof of its legal representatives, assigns, and/or successors, to the full  
8 end of the term and any extensions thereof for which any and all said Letters Patent  
9 may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us had  
10 this assignment and sale not been made.

11 And we, John E. McDowell, Clark E. Hinds and John L. Fleskes, hereby  
12 covenant and agree that we will at any time, upon request, execute and deliver any  
13 and all papers that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the titles of said  
14 Assignee or its successors or assigns to said invention and to any and all Letters  
15 Patent that may be granted therefor, both domestic and foreign, as well as any and all  
16 Letters Patent granted upon any divisional, reissue, re-examination, continuation,  
17 and/or continuation-in-part applications claiming priority thereof, both domestic and  
18 foreign, as well as any and all extensions of term therefor.

19 This agreement will be interpreted in accordance with the Federal patent laws  
20 and the laws of the State of Tennessee, without regard to any provisions of conflicts of  
21 laws.

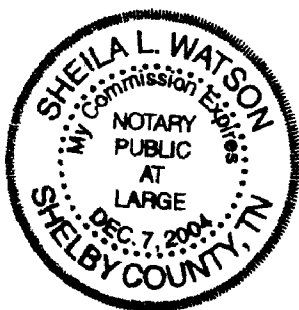

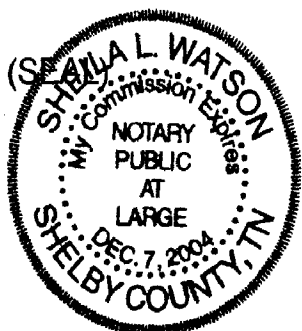


