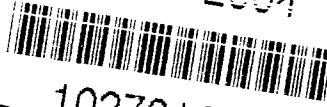

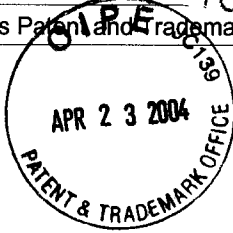

(Neonics and Baker are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "**Assignor**"), and



AND WHEREAS Assignee wishes to acquire all right, title, and interest to the Patents.


NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

Assignor agrees to sign or otherwise execute all such documents requested by the Assignee in order to perfect Assignee's ownership rights in and to the Patents.


