WHEREAS, we, **Stephen W. Swaine**, of Fife, United Kingdom; **Charles G.V. Rohan**, of Dundee, United Kingdom; **David C. McGinn**, of Perthshire, United Kingdom; and **Andrew Colley**, of Dundee, United Kingdom (hereinafter called "the inventors"), have invented certain new and useful improvements in **SELF-SERVICE TERMINAL**, Docket No. **11696.00** (hereinafter called "the invention"), for which we have executed an application for a Letters Patent of the United States of America (hereinafter called "the application") on same date herewith, respectively; and


