RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST – PATENT



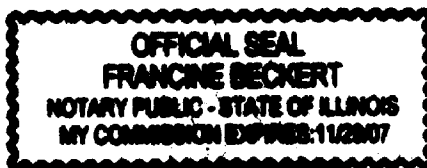
