ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS

This ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS, dated as of July 19, 2004 ("Assignment"), by Huffy Corporation, an Ohio corporation located at 225 Byers Road, Miamisburg, Ohio 45342 ("Assignor"), in favor of Russell Corporation, an Alabama corporation located at 3330 Cumberland Blvd., Atlanta, GA 30339 ("Assignee").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Assignor and Assignee are parties to that certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated July 19, 2004 (the "Asset Purchase Agreement"), pursuant to which Assignor has agreed to sell, convey, transfer, assign, set over and deliver to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the patent applications and patents listed on Schedule A hereto (the "Patents") among other Acquired Assets (as defined in the Asset Purchase Agreement);

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2004, the parties executed an Assignment of Patents, an agreement (the "Original Agreement") which contains certain typographical errors the parties discovered after execution. The parties hereby execute this agreement which amends, supersedes, and confirms (subject to the corrected typographical errors) the Original Agreement, for the sole purpose of correcting said typographical errors contained therein. This Agreement shall be deemed to be effective for all purposes as of the date and time of execution of the Original Agreement on July 19, 2004; and

WHEREAS, Assignor desires to sell, convey, transfer, assign, set over and deliver to Assignee, and Assignee desires to acquire, all of Assignor's right title and interest in and to the Patents.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby sell, convey, transfer, assign, set over and deliver to Assignee all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to (i) the Patents including all inventions disclosed and claimed therein, and all continuations, divisionals, continuations-in-part, renewals and reissues, and including without limitation the subject matter of all claims which may be obtained therefrom, rights of priority under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the Inter-American Convention Relating to Patents, Designs and Industrial Models, and any other international agreements to which the United States adheres; (ii) all causes of action (either in law or equity) and the right to sue, counterclaim, and recover for past, present, and future infringement, or other violation of the Patents; (iii) all income, royalties, damages and payments now or hereafter due or payable with respect to the Patents; and (iv) all rights corresponding thereto throughout the world, for Assignee's own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of Assignee's successors, assigns or other legal representatives.


Assignor authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to record Assignee as owner of the Patents, including any continuations, divisionals, continuations-in-part, renewals and reissues thereof, and to issue any and all

Patents to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the same, for the sole use and enjoyment of Assignee, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

Assignor shall reasonably cooperate with Assignee in executing appropriate assignment documents provided by Assignee required for completing the formalities to secure to Assignee the rights hereby transferred, upon request of such Assignee.


