## ASSIGNMENT

Assignment made by the Howard Hughes Medical Institute, a Delaware corporation (the "Institute"), to University of Michigan (the "University").

WHEREAS, the Institute and the University collaborate in the active conduct of medical research pursuant to an Affiliation Agreement and Patent and Intellectual Property Agreement between them dated as of December 7, 1984 (the "Agreement");

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the Institute has agreed to assign to the University the Institute's rights with respect to inventions, discoveries, improvements, and other intellectual property, whether patentable or copyrightable (each a "Subject Property"), conceived or reduced to practice in the course of the research program conducted under the Agreement by employees of the Institute; and

WHEREAS, research conducted pursuant to the Agreement by Gary J. Nabel, M.D., Ph.D. while employed by the Institute at the University has resulted in an invention entitled "A Novel p27 Binding Protein, hKIS" (the "Invention"), and the Invention is a subject property;




