ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, **Nilesh Tralshawala**, and **James Claycomb**, made an invention jointly with **Harold Weinstock**, entitled **WIRE DETECTION SYSTEM**, and described in application for Letters Patent of the United States executed by me on the 3rd day of June 1999, and on the 1st day of June 1999. Application Serial No. 09/332,639 filed on 14 June 1999.

NOW, THEREFORE, to all whom it may concern, be it known that for and in consideration of the premises and other valuable considerations, we, **Nilesh Tralshawala**, and **James Claycomb**, have sold, assigned and transferred and by these presents do sell, assign and transfer unto the Government of the United States of America as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, our undivided right, title and interest throughout the United States of America, its territories and dependencies, in and to the aforesaid invention described in the aforesaid application for Letters Patent of the United States, and all Letters Patent issuing thereon and any continuations, divisions and reissues or extensions thereof; we hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents to issue said Letters Patent to the Government of the United States of America, as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, and his/her successors, as assignee of our undivided right, title and interest in and to the same throughout the United States of America, its territories and dependencies, for the sole use for the full term or terms for which said Letters Patent and any continuations, divisions and reissues or extensions thereof are, or may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us, **Nilesh Tralshawala**, and **James Claycomb**, had this assignment not been made; and we do hereby also grant unto the Government of the United States as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, the option to take our undivided right, title and interest in said invention or all applications for Letters Patent thereon in all countries foreign to the United States in which the Government of the United States may file, or cause to be filed, applications for Letters Patent, without payment to us of any further consideration; provided, however, that this grant of an option to take foreign rights in the joint invention, or application for Letters Patent thereon, shall have force and effect only as to such applications filed in foreign countries within six months of the filing date of any application for United States Letters Patent covering said joint invention, or within six months from the declassification of said invention, whichever is later, and that all foreign rights in said undivided interest not exercised under the option are left to me subject to a nonexclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free license to the Government of the United States in our undivided interest in any patent which may issue on said invention in any foreign country, including the power to issue sub-licenses for use in behalf of the Government of the United States and/or in furtherance of the foreign policies of the Government of the United States, and we, **Nilesh Tralshawala**, and **James Claycomb**, hereby agree to execute any and all applications for Letters Patent, and to furnish all data and documents and to execute any papers which may be necessary for the preparation of filing of such domestic applications, or for the Government to exercise its option

granted hereunder, except that it shall be understood that I shall not be subject to any out-of-pocket expense relative to such action.

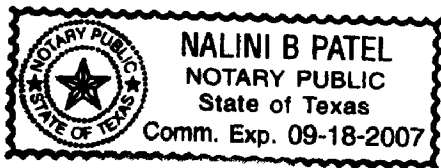
