
ASSIGNMENT

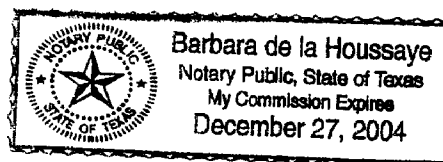
